Why will a Home Rule Charter make the city better?

The Home Rule Concept- In *Forwood v. City of Taylor*, the Texas Supreme Court summarized Texas' home rule doctrine as follows:

It was the purpose of the Home-Rule Amendment...to bestow upon accepting cities and towns of more than 5,000 population full power of self-government, that is, full authority to do anything the legislature could therefore have authorized them to do. The result is that now it is necessary to look to the acts of legislature not for grants of power to such cities but only for limitation on their powers.

- City Government structure left entirely to the discretion of local voters (size, qualifications, term, when majority vote required, who nominates, appoints and removes members of boards etc.)
- City Administrative structure is also left to citizens (prohibits council dictating or directing city employees etc.)
- Initiative, Referendum & Recall
- Charter Amendments- Under Section 9.0004 of the Local Government Code, citizens can require their city council to call an election on a proposed charter amendment by simply filing a petition signed by ten percent (initiative) twenty percent (referendum) and twenty-five percent (recall) of the qualified voters. Voter-initiated charter amendments, if adopted, can change most aspects of the city government.

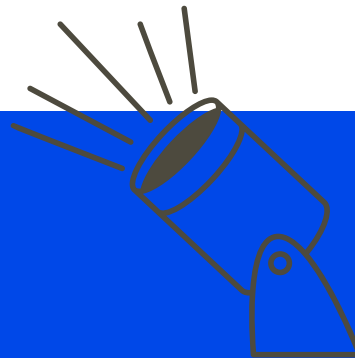


