So, you are ready to hire your first (or next) employee....

WHAT TO INCLUDE IN A JOB DESCRIPTION

A good job description should include a company overview and job overview, as well as an explanation of the associated responsibilities, skills & qualifications, and work environment. Below are some general guidelines for writing each of these sections effectively.

1. COMPANY OVERVIEW- Providing an accurate, concise description of your business is a great way to attract the right employees. Think of this section as an advertisement for your company - why should prospective employees want to join your team?

Some useful things to include here are core company values; mission statement; brief history of your organization; anticipated growth; business goals

2. JOB OVERVIEW- In a few sentences, describe the purpose, importance, and fundamental qualities of the position being offered. No need to be too specific or comprehensive here - the idea is to provide a zoomed-out image of the role the applicant would be filling in your company.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES- This is where you'll outline the specific day-to-day responsibilities of the job. Bullet-point format is typically the most practical way to present this information.

4. NECESSARY SKILLS & QUALIFICATIONS- List in bulleted format the skills & qualifications that are absolutely essential to this position. Consider as many specific conditions of the job as possible in order to create a complete list of qualifications an applicant must have in order to succeed.

5. PREFERRED SKILLS & QUALIFICATIONS- List in bulleted format the skills & qualifications that are not essential but would make an applicant more eligible for the position being offered.

6. WORK ENVIRONMENT- Describe the environment in which the applicant would be spending most of their time. In this description, include information about company culture; pace of work; amount of collaborative vs. independent activity; who the employee will report to (or vice versa)

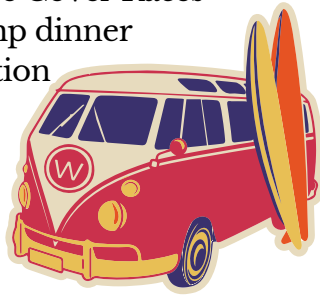
