

THE CITY- HOW IT GOT IT'S NAME

The City of Morgan's Point Resort is named for the James E. Morgan Family, owners of a large share of the land on which the municipality was developed. Mr. Morgan built his home in what was called Tennessee Valley on the Leon River in 1885. In the early 1960's, most of the Morgan estate was sold to the Great Western Investment Corporation (later Terramar Corporation) and the Lakeshore Development Company. These two commercial enterprises were responsible for the birth of the City, contributed to its ultimate shape and character, and named most of the city streets as a promotional device to attract customers. Terramar's sales office, deeded to the City in 1976, served for many years as the City Hall.

On June 16, 1970, an application proposing incorporation of the City was supported by twenty-eight people. An election to decide the issue was ordered held on June 30, 1970. The name proposed for the City was Morgan's Point. "Resort" was added because a Morgan's Point, Texas already existed. The City of Morgan's Point Resort became an incorporated city by a vote of thirty-seven for, twenty-three against, and one blank ballot. The City was officially incorporated on July 1, 1970.

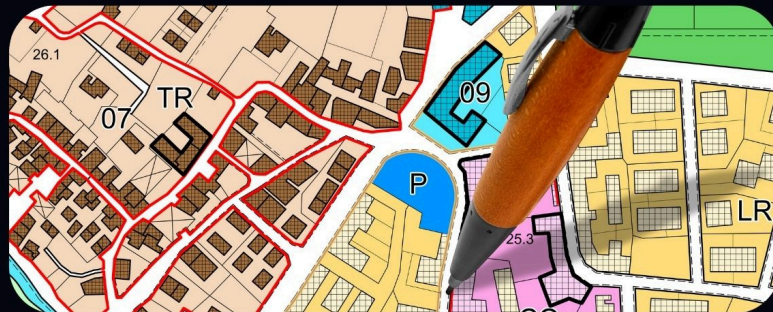

- Verify all property owners and residents within 200 feet of the property for which change in zoning is proposed have been notified by City Staff.
- Every five years, review all zoning regulations and propose, in coordination with the City Staff to the City Council, any needed changes resulting from the review.
- Receive all requests for changes in zoning or variances from zoning regulations and make appropriate recommendations to the City Council.

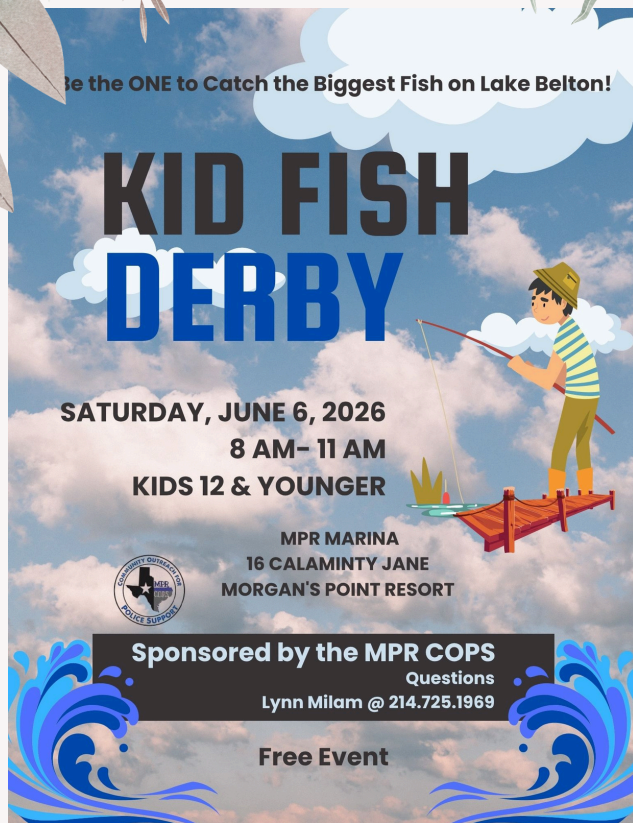

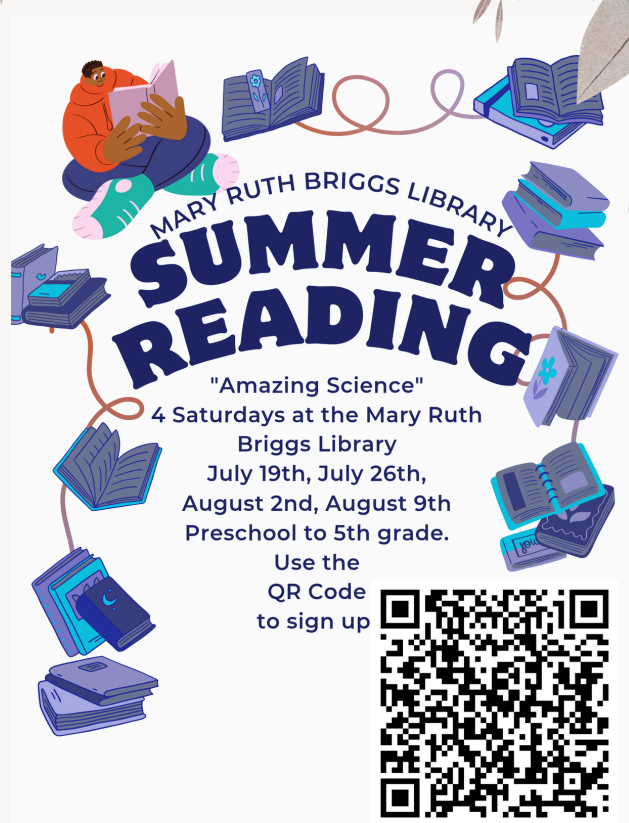
